Operating a so-called 'commercial kitchen' in the middle of Swiss Cottage, a densely residential area, is a nuisance and contributes to traffic congestion (whether moped or bicycle) and air pollution (from frequent food supply vehicles). The operating 'footprint' and impact of this facility is far wider than the specific property itself, and has a direct impact on local residents in surrounding communities, all of which are designated conservation areas. This facility is better suited to an industrial park or large retail parking lot. I do not see how this a welcome addition to our community. Although the application states that only bicycles will be used, I believe this will be a temporary measure. The moped traffic on this block already is egregious; last Friday at 6pm there were 13 mopeds all parked on the sidewalk, and the next day at 11am, 8 were parked there, some with Deliveroo boxes. This is ridiculous. It's like a Vespa convention on our sidewalks! I note that the Royal Society for Public Health has opposed these facilities, due to the negative impact on local businesses and employment, and loss of income to local authorities. They also cite issues with licensing, poor food safety, and lack of allergen controls.
