NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A
CONSERVATION AREA

Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Cherry (Prunus spp) (T1) - Reduce all over by up to 2m and selectively thin 10%, taking care of hazard beam in main stem.

- 1 x Eucalyptus spp (T2) Reduce height by up to 5.5m and balance taking care of large overhang, remove lowest two limbs and end weight of lower canopy to raise crown.
- 1 x Willow (Salix spp) (T3) Reduce sides by up to 2-3m and crown thin by 30%.
- 1 x Prunus spp (T5) Reduce height by up to 2m and balance in sides by 2m, crown thin 20% to enable Magnolia to flourish.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 14 June 2019 and does not wish to object.

Informative(s):

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, which ever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these



- standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.
- Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife.
