Dear Mr Fowler,

I am writing to you to object to the Planning Application to convert the Hampstead Police Station to the Abacus Belsize School being located in Hampstead.

As a resident of Eldon Grove, I experience weekly the congestion the school run and regular traffic creates in the mornings and afternoons in Hampstead at the junction of Thurlow Road, Rosslyn Hill & Downshire Hill.

Opening another school on this junction will create unnecessary congestion and an increase in pollution by parents dropping and collecting children.

To open another school in an area where school spaces are in excess of demand and to have one that has a dedicated catchment area which supposedly excludes Hampstead children is completely ill-judged and entirely pointless.

The cost of this school is unnecessary, the increase in pollution is worrying and the inevitable increase in traffic it will bring must be avoided by not granting the planning permission.

As a resident of Hampstead I am registering my objection and would be very grateful if this would be taken in to consideration.
