Introducing another drinking venue with considerably late opening times would only cause further problems in an area which has in recent years had significant increase in residential homes. The use of the outdoor terrace for parties in this location is already disrupting residents. Opening this back as a drinking area would not only cause noise disturbance but would pose a risk of security due to the close proximity of this terrace to residential terraces and homes.</p>
