Permission is sought to conservatively prune 2 trees within the property boundary of 265 Goldhurst Terrace, NW6 3EP, as follows:

1) Tree One: Ash

The owner of the neighbouring property, 267 Goldhurst Terrace has complained that overhanging branches from this tree are causing damage to the tiles on his roof. We have consulted a tree surgeon and been advised that the branches and the part of the trunk that they grow from should be removed. The remainder of the tree would not be touched.

2) Tree Two: Maple

A maple seedling, also in the boundary of 265 Goldhurst Terrace, is rooted 2 - 3 metres from the house and growing very rapidly (1 m a year). It has previously been pruned to the level of the top of the first floor of the property (a reduction of 3 - 4 metres in height versus today). Permission is sought to prune back to
