IN GROUNDS TO FRONT/SIDE: 5 x Limes (T1 - T5) - Crown reduction back to most recent pruning points leaving furnishing growth and lift crown to 5m from ground level.  
1 x Oak (T6) - Crown reduction of 20% (1.5m), lift crown to 3m from ground level and thin crown by 20%.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 04 July 2019 and does not wish to object.
