## **2. Normal Opening Hours**

Parliament Hill School is open for educational purposes, on Monday to Friday from 8.40am to 3.15pm.

The school is open to staff on Monday to Friday from 7am to 7pm.

The school is open to visitors other than for lettings, on Monday to Friday from 8am to 4pm

## **3. Lettings**

The school welcomes lettings out of normal school opening hours on Monday to Friday from 4pm to 11pm, on Saturday from 8am to 11pm and on Sunday from 9am to 7pm.

## **4. Use of Sports Hall and Kite Building facing private habitable property**

Classrooms facing Lissenden Gardens will be restricted for lettings on Monday to Friday from 4.00pm to 6pm and on Saturday and Sunday from 9am to 6pm.

The sports hall facing Lissenden Gardens, specifically Clevedon Mansions, will be used on Monday to Friday from 8.40am to 3.15pm during term time for PE lessons. These will include trampolining, tennis, netball, football, badminton, basketball, fitness, gym and any other curriculum based sports.

It will be restricted for lettings on Monday to Friday from 4pm to 10pm, on Saturday from 8am to 10pm and on Sunday from 9am to 7pm.

All classrooms and the sports hall have been built with sound bafflers in place to reduce noise pollution/disruption.

## **5. Access**

Students in year's 7-11 are expected to use the student gate and entrance into the Kite building at all times. Students in year's 12 & 13 may use the main student entrance or the 6<sup>th</sup> form entrance depending on where their classes are being taught.

Staff may access the site via any of the school's front or back gates, including the vehicle gate.

Visitors are directed to the visitor entrance in the Morant Building via the visitor gate.

Hirers are informed that they should use the student entrance into the Kite Building.
