Sycamore (T2) - Remove large dying stem and reduce the 3 remaining stems by 3m on all aspects. Remove any dead wood and rubbing branches. Poplar (T3) - Reduce height by 50% (approx. 8m). The trees are very large and hang over many gardens. They need pruning to keep them in check and reduce any chance of limbs failing. The sycamore is partly dying and need sorting out. The poplar has decay at the base and need pollarding to reduce chance of failure. 6.
