2019/2639/P	Richard Simpson for Regent's Park CAAC	29/07/2019 18:14:08	OBJ	<p>The Regent's Park Conservation Area Advisory Committee 12A Manley Street, London NW1 8LT</p> <p>1 July 2019</p> <p>St George's Cathedral Redhill Street London NW1 4BG      2019/2639/P + 2019/2937/L</p> <p>Erection of first floor extension to north eastern annex on Little Edward Street to provide ancillary rooms.</p> <p>Objection.</p> <p>We object strongly to the insertion of the stair and box enclosure proposed which would harm both ground floor and gallery level.</p> <p>The proposed stair and enclosure would be intrusive and harmful to the simple geometry of the church interior, which consists of a rectangular form with galleries, with a double-recessed space for the altar. This stepped effect is powerful in the context of the simple rectangle of the body of the church: the introduction of the stair box would harm the geometry and harmony of the original and surviving design by disrupting the surviving volumes.</p> <p>The original design, by architect Sir James Pennethorne, has been supplemented by changes by distinguished architects, R. C. Carpenter and William Butterfield. Their work, including decorative details, gives greater value to the interior spaces and emphasizes the harm that the proposal would have on the Grade II* Listed Building.</p> <p>We do not object to the alterations to the exterior proposed.</p> <p>Richard Simpson FSA Chair.</p>
