Planning Application 2019/3138/P

This plan appears to have no connection to Camden High Street, with regard to size, height and function.

The plans I have seen show a building twice the height of the buildings on either side. This will be oppressive and over dominating the human scale of the High Street. The present building which will be pulled down to facilitate this is much more in scale with Street, but at the present is obscured by an ugly signboard which is being presented to us as the only alternative.

It is also proposing the main entrance to the large capacity hotel be on Delancey Street, a residential street with families and young children. This will entail cars/ taxis stopping in a relatively narrow one way street. The proposed nature of the hotel supplying numerous small rooms, up to 100, many without windows, sounds like an enormous hostel not suitable for the Victorian Street. To put so many people on one relatively small area sounds like over crowding.

I object to the planning permission on the above grounds.
