I object to the planning proposal for 65 Camden Square, NW1 9XD.

As the original plans for a two-storey development were refused but

passed on appeal, it would be erroneous to give permission for a further storey to be added, making it a three storey high building in

a designated Conservation Area.

The plans show a bulk mass to the edge of Camden Mews, with a loss of light and trees.

I notice no mention of replacement of trees in the application.

The two-storey cottage is currently in a pretty garden with trees, all to be demolished for an edifice too large for its surroundings in a Conservation Area.

Camden were right to refuse the original application, it makes sense to refuse it now, at a time when we need more space and more trees.
