REFUSAL OF CONSENT FOR WORKS TO TREE/S UNDER A TREE PRESERVATION ORDER

Proposal:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Ash - Prune 30 - 40% all over and root management of 30 - 40%.

The Council has considered your application dated 11 June 2019 and decided to refuse consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed works specification of "root management of 30-40%" is considered too vague and is not supported by an arboricultural method statement. Contact was made with the applicant advising that it was likely that the application would be refused in its current form and that it is recommended an arboricultural professional is employed to assist. There has been no response from the applicant.

Included with the application is a copy of a letter regarding the rebuilding of a damage boundary wall, which is from LB Camden. While some degree of root



pruning may be acceptable in order to facilitate the reconstruction of the wall, the submitted works specification is not considered acceptable as no attempt has been made to demonstrate how the tree will be protected from damage.

The application be refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides.
