Lime - removal of existi	ng tree, and grinding stump out to prevent regrowth.					
Lime tree is disproportionate in size and height to front garden, and causes excessive shading to property. Growth has also caused structural issues with front boundary brick wall (a number of cornice bricks have fallen off the wall), and it has had to be rebuilt twice.						
We propose replanting a semi-mature Acer in the same position, so we continue to have a range of planting (and a semi-mature tree) in the front garden.
