				For a long while, mopeds and cars used for pick ups were parking in Dobson Close which was extremely disruptive and noisy. The riders/drivers would gather in the car park, talk loudly, shout to each other, and they would leave litter in the car park.
				The odour from cooking is also very noticeable and, at times, it has been impossible for me to have my flat windows open such is the stench of cooking oil/food.
				The massive verits they erected on the side of the building are an eyesore and will most definitely be contributing to pollution.
				Since the change to e-bikes/scooters, the noise has certainly lessened but the vehicles are still being ridden dangerously - the wrong way down Finchley Road, on the pavements in the surrounding area, and weaving in and out of traffic on local roads. It is very difficult to hear them coming now they do not have engines and I have been started a few times by having them overtake me ON THE PAVEMENT to reach the slip road to get to a pick up. The riders are a menace to the local population.
				There is a constant low humming coming from the vents. I am not sure why this has become more noticeable of late. I am making a log of the noise and also reporting it via the Camden Noise Team.
