The terrace will overlook the clear glass roof I have in my flat which is between a bedroom and the kitchen and would invade my privacy. My daughter would be unable to walk from the bedroom to the bathroom without being seen from the new terrace. This is unacceptable as she has Aspergers and suffers from anxiety.</li><li>2. The terrace will block any direct sunlight into my garden and also affect the light levels in my flat. The direct sunlight in the garden and lack of light in the flat will have a big impact as it is already limited. In the summer I use the garden frequently as it has a lovely secluded feel and provides additional space. Any one stood on the terrace would infringe the space in my garden and inhibit my use of the garden and prevent my daughter using it at all.</li><li>3. The main bedroom in my flat is at the front of the property and according to the proposal will then be next to the main living area. It would be a nightmare if the room next to my bedroom became the main living space with TV, music, loud talking. There has already been load noise from no 5 which have affected my sleep. I note all the other similar properties in the road have the front lower ground floor as a bedroom. The revision of the internal design appears to be contrary to the standard usage of these properties.</li></ol> <p>I am also concerned that the flat above me, no 6, would be overlooked from the terrace, as there will be a direct view into the windows from the terrace.</p> <p>I oppose this application, and would welcome any one from the planning office/councillors to visit my property to see the impact this application would have.</p>
