This is a very important site for wild life and forms a link between the urban and wildlife habitat of the heath. Previous plans allow for the removal of an area of land to create the permitted development extensions where bushes and trees offer substantial resources for moths, butterflies and insects that create habitat and food for bats, birds and other mammals living on the edges of Hampstead Heath. It is important to make sure that as much of this habitat as possible is preserved or re-instated. Hard landscaping removes potential habitat for living things. Please make sure that as much area as possible is preserved for wild life and building work does not commence during the nesting season.
