Dear Sir/Madam,

I represent the freeholders of West End Court where the tree object of the above notification is located - I am one of the directors of the freehold company (West End court Ltd) and owner of a flat in the building. I have just recently been made aware of your letter of 1 August by a resident. I wish to express my opposition to the works until we have had the chance to consult a tree surgeon. The problem is that the tree is right next to the boundary and a "3m lateral reduction north side only" "back to boundary line" would mean to cut half of the canopy.

This, apart from any aesthetic consideration, could mean I believe to risk damaging the tree, possibly irreversibly. I am attaching a couple of photos to give you a sense of the situation, and I hope that we can reach a reasonable solution for all concerned.
