Reason(s) for Refusal

The proposed advertisement, by virtue of its size, scale, design, location, method of illumination, and orientation (facing the Grade II* listed public house) would be an incongruous and bulky feature that would introduce an illuminated fixture as well as create visual clutter at high level, detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building and wider streetscene, and fail to preserve the settings of the Grade II* listed building located opposite and the adjacent locally listed public park, contrary to policies D1, D2 and D4 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
