

EVIDENCE OF THE DEMAND FOR CHILDCARE WITHIN THE WEST HAMPSTEAD AREA

Introduction

The purpose of this document is to outline and evidence the demand for childcare within the vicinity of 13 Woodchurch Road, London NW6 3PL. The definition of 'childcare' in relation to this document refers to all settings registered with OFSTED to provide care and an EYFS education to children aged under 5 years of age.

As a part of N Family Club's appraisal of the site, a competitor analysis of the area was carried out in order to establish the need for a new nursery. This involved collecting data on all the nurseries and preschools operating within a 1 mile radius of the site, with particular attention paid to available spaces. Information has been collected through internet research, the OFSTED information portal, and direct contact with the nurseries themselves.

Competitor Analysis

A competitor analysis of the area found there to be 25 settings within a 1 mile radius of the site.

We were able to make direct contact with 21 of the 25 settings. Out of the 21 settings contacted, 19 are operating some form of waiting list for spaces. This number includes all of the settings rated by OFSTED to be 'Requires Improvement'.

As well as a shortage of overall availability, we also identified a distinct lack of full-time childcare provision in the area, as well as care for children aged under 2 years of age. Of the 25 settings analysed, 10 are term-time only, and 13 of the 25 do not take children younger than 2 years old.

Measured Interest - N Family Club's Sales Campaign

The success of N Family Club's own pre-launch sales campaign acts as further testimony to the shortage of childcare places in the area. Following the launch of the campaign just 7 weeks ago, 59 of the future nursery's places have already been sold. Additionally, enquiries have been consistently high, with 160 to date.

Demographic Statistics

Demographic statistics for the area provide an explanation for the high demand for childcare within the area, as well as providing a projection of future demand. We used a CACI location analysis software to obtain the demographic metrics of the site's ward, Swiss Cottage.



The area has an extremely high number of children aged 0-4 years - 7,452 in a 1 mile radius. In way of comparison, London averages 6,100 in a 1 mile radius.

Statistics also suggest that the atypical number of young children will be a future as well as present trend - birth rates are incredibly high, with 1,582 recorded within a 1 mile radius for 2018. This is in comparison to an average of 1,327 for the city. Additionally, there is a high proportion of women of typical child-bearing age (25-39 years) in the area - 18,377 compared to London's average of 14,515.

Conclusion

With the vast majority of the area's childcare settings operating waiting lists for places, it is clear that there is a local need for more nurseries. This becomes particularly apparent when noting the high percentage of term-time only settings, and those that do not accept younger children. The size of nurseries does not impact the availability of spaces - an example being the nearby Bright Horizons Active Learning West Hampstead. This site has a capacity of 164, yet currently has no places available for babies until 2020.

Demographic statistics provide confidence that this trend will continue into the future, with much higher than average numbers of children, births, and women of child-bearing age.

Finally, the level of interest that N Family Club's own pre-launch sales campaign is generating provides us with a live indicator of the shortage of quality childcare places in the vicinity. We have a great deal of confidence that we will quickly reach the site's allotted capacity, and therefore hope to see this increase from 80 to 100 places.
