1 Reasons for approval:

Condition 4 requires details of the external materials to be used for the infill extension to include product specifications and samples.

The proposed material for the infill extension is marble (Calacatta Michelangelo), which is a white marble with grey veining. This would be cut into 20mm sheets and would span the full height of the extension with vertical joints to the side elevation to the infill extension. The sheets would be bonded onto ply which is then fixed back on to blockwork. A sample has been provided and

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considered is considered acceptable.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed under the parent planning application. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host building and wider terrace.
