Dear Rachel,

Thank you most kindly for notifying us about the new planning application for the land at 156 West End Lane *after* we had already emailed you about it.

However, you have failed to address the substantive point we made about Camden Council's abject failure to notify any of the 1,100+ people — legitimate interested parties which include many residents from the adjacent Lymington Road and many of the other streets nearby — that a new application had been lodged. You have also not addressed our request that the period for comments be extended.

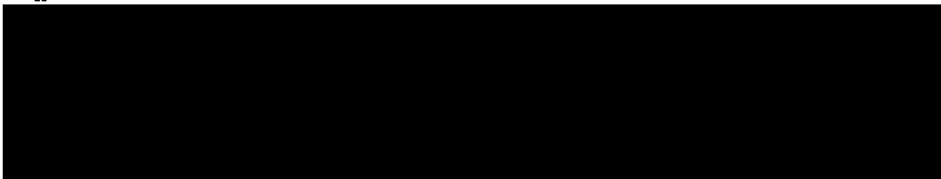
As the organisation that rallied over 1,100 individual objections to the original application — a feat described at Planning Committee by Councillor Flick Rea as "an unprecedented number of local objections" — and given the extreme level of local opposition to the original proposal, we believe it is incumbent on the council to notify all the original objectors for whom contact details are held. We are well aware that a good number of the 1,100+ objections contained either an email address, phone number and/or mailing address.

We note that you sign as 'Supporting Communities Directorate' and would ask that you support the community in West Hampstead who have already commented on these plans and are entitled to comment on these new proposals. To not do so is to ignore the community.
