This would increase our living costs in terms of lighting, heating etc. The dislocation of demolishing & building of the building causing huge amounts of dust to enter our flats is worrying. I see no reason why the building has to be 7 stories high. The present height is perfectly adequate. It has also been pointed out that this proposal is for a conservation area; The demolition & rebuilding will cause traffic chaos on W.E.L. The use thereafter will also add to an overcrowded traffic & overflowing pedestrian use. In my view I think the 156 could be refurbished to a standard for people to live in as is now. Lastly I would point out that Notice of this Application has not been forwarded to any one living in 217-229 A.B.C W.E.L. I only found about this from a notice attached to a Lamp post W.E.L.
