Dear Sir/Madam,

As secretary of the management company for [REDACTED] Maresfield Gardens, we are AGAINST the proposed works to the two poplar trees (T2 and T3) "the trees", on the adjoining property, as above, and base our objections on the following:

1. In the immediate locality of our house it is considered that the trees help to reduce the air pollution within our immediate vicinity, possibly saving many lives in a conservation area. Please refer to draft legislation currently to be presented to parliament. It is also understood that the trees are subject to a Tree Preservation Order which should be respected. The proposal to cut these trees to ground level is not accepted.
 2. The trees also act as a much needed barrier against noise from two schools immediately behind the trees.
 3. The trees, presently, have been culled but may need to be shaped, and this, we feel should be sufficient to protect the environment.
 4. The trees act as a backdrop to this house and garden as well as other properties and where there is a dearth of trees in the immediate vicinity.
