In June 2016, Pre-Planning application enquiry with the Council (LPA Ref. 2016/3367/PRE) in which it proposed upgrading 35 Telephone Kiosks and ks as part of an overall rationalisation exercise. The Council responded in Sept. 2016. Following the Council's response, Prior Approval nent Consent applications were submitted in 2018 for upgrading 26 kiosks and removing 45. Of the 26 sets of related applications 23 allly by the Council subject to completing a S.278 agreement, needed to secure the kiosk removal, tree planting, and cleaning and osks. 78 agreement was concluded, a judgement was handed down in the High Court the effect of which was to clarify the scope of the GPDO. The Council wrote to the applicant stating that it was unable to determine the applications as is, requested that they be withdrawn and instead apply for planning permission.
