Trees at 3 Bacon's Lane, London N6 6BL.

We have taken over this house which was occupied by the same family since 1956. The last resident died two years ago at the age of 93 and the garden suffers from neglect.

We would like to carry out the following works at the above address to enable us to restore the garden and plant trees.

(To be read in conjunction with enclosed Google Earth photograph, trees marked with white area.)

The trees at the SW of the garden are overshadowed and bent forward in an attempt to find light, they are cherries, overhang the road and do not produce fruit. Another tree is so emasculated by ivy and darkness that it is impossible to tell what species it is. A hawthorn has substantial rot at its base. A large red maple is over massing and makes it impossible to plant the border.

We would like to:

Remove 2X cherries to make space for future landscaping and tree planting

Damaged tree suffocated by ivy. Remove.

Damaged, dying hawthorn. Remove.

Red Maple. Crown lift to approx. 8 meters and thin crown.

All work to be carried out by NPTC Qualified tree surgeons.
