ROBINA TREE at Eight and a Half Parliament Hill, London NW3 2SY

I understand I should advise you with six weeks notice as the above mentioned tree is in a Conservation Area, that we would like to fell the tree.

The reason is that our neighbours in 8 Parliament Hill suggest that the tree is causing their property damage, by its deep root system. The tree has been in position since the house was built in early 1980's. It is in a small space and the height of both properties have caused the tree to grow very tall (towards the light) it is also in a small space causing the roots to spread widely for water. We, ourselves, feel the tree (and they are not long lived trees) should be removed and replaced with a Cammellia shrub more appropriate to the space, however, this is subject to your approval.
