To whom it may concern,

In response to the above mentioned planning application of the felling to ground level of a beautiful L.plane tree due to subsidence problems, I would want to suggest to bring in another tree with less root forming, such as a crabapple, a Rowan or a cherrie/pear tree, so that not all greenery is lost. It will give some shade and colour to the back area. The same suggestion would count for the Ash tree in the back, that provides a lot of green as well; the felling to the ground of this tree due to rotting at it's base also causes an enormous loss of green, so putting something back in its place, as suggested before will be hugely appreciated.
