

The following objections to the proposal by HS2, ref 2019/4700/HS2, represent several families in Hawkshead block of flats in Stanhope Street and others who have asked me to speak on their behalf.

We are united in our objections to the planning application to run up to two hundred trucks along Stanhope Street and Robert Street over a two year period.

We have had to live through more than a two year nightmare because of HS2. Easier and Cheaper for who?

We suggest HS2 keep to their original "thought" of a dedicated **HAUL ACCESS ROAD** from the land straight onto Hampstead Road for the lorries.

The long term health and safety of Stanhope Street and Robert must be a priority, not finance.

We would also like to suggest the Varndell Street / Hampstead junction be changed to allow traffic coming from Camden Town to turn right into Varndell Street.

At present it is near impossible to get into this area because of all the HS2 disruption and ambiguous road signs.

Another concern raised;

Will the pollution levels be monitored and how do the residents get to see the pollution figures.

All the people I have spoken to are totally against this planning Application and generally feel HS2 are treating the local community with contempt.

When trying to comment on the planning application one neighbor got the following reply.

"The north side of Regents Park has been 500 - Internal server error.
