OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A
CONSERVATION AREA

Description:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Oak (T2) - Fell to ground level.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 13 June 2019 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

Reasons for objection:

The oak tree is highly visible from the public realm and is considered to provide a high level of visual amenity and to make a positive contribution to the character of the area. It appears to be in good condition displaying good vigour. Additionally the tree provides screening between properties and is of an ecologically valuable species.

The application alleges that the tree is implicated as a cause of subsidence in an adjacent property however it is considered that insufficient evidence to justify the removal of a tree that is worthy of being brought under the protection of a TPO has been submitted as this does not include crack and/or level monitoring



demonstrating a pattern of seasonal movement in line with the expected moisture uptake of vegetation.

A tree preservation order has been served to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and preserve the character of the conservation area.

A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.
