It is a cynical further step to an already greatly detested development in which the community had no say and their voices were greatly ignored.</p> <p>Camden council has failed to notify me even though I submitted objections to the original application, being a resident directly adjacent to the site.</p> <p>I request that Camden planners ensure all site notices are properly posted in the locality, and that the comments period for the variation recommences only from the point at which all notices are actually in place.</p> <p>I deeply object the latest variations of the development which include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Nearly 50% more one-bedroom units, with the original 69 one-bed units increasing to 102 - A 10% increase in total units, from 164 to 180 - Even more densely packed, with density increased even further in excess of the London Plan maximum - Reduction of the originally proposed paltry 'public open space' (on what will be private land and therefore not 'public' in any meaningful sense of the word) - Drastic changes to the internal layouts, windows and balconies <p>I can only strongly urge you to LISTEN TO THE OBJECTIONS, WE (THE RESIDENTS) HAVE TO LIVE WITH THE CONSEQUENCES OF YOUR DECISIONS!</p>
