You recently wrote to inform her that there would be a massive increase in noise and pollution over the next 2 years because HS2 would be using the roads to bring materials and equipment to the HS2 site at Euston.

I am emailing to protest about this.

The increase in pollution will have a direct impact on my Mother-in Laws health and quality of life. She has been diagnosed with a chronic lung disease and the increase in traffic along the streets you mentioned in your letter will aggravate her condition. It will mean she cannot leave the house or open her door or windows. This is not acceptable.

I have been looking on Camden.gov site to read the section relating to commitments you gained from HS2 and it clearly states that you 'secured commitments that will limit HS2 construction vehicle emissions' and 'look for ways to maximise materials transported by rail to reduce vehicles on our roads'.
