Observations The continuous internally illuminated sign running along the

string course is not acceptable as it will have a detrimental impact on the appearance of the building and will not preserve the character of the Conservation Area at this very important and busy junction. We object strongly to this particular aspect of the proposal and any other proposed internally illuminated signage on this prominent and important building. Note that the committee does not object however to the loss of a single stall riser either side of the main entrance doors as this will allow for better visibility of the interior and hopefully enhance viability. We do have concerns that there may be interesting architectural details within the interior which will be lost if half of the first floor is removed but if there are none remaining then providing a double height space is not something that the committee

would be adverse to as proposed.
