



Further to my telephone conversation with Jenny Reid today, I confirm that with regard to the application for conservation area consent for the Leeke Street Block (CAVI), number 6 Leeke Street is to be retained. The application was amended on 26 February 1992 to reflect the fact that number 6 Leeke Street is to be retained. I attach a copy of the original letter, and in addition, copies of the revised schedule 1 (which lists the buildings to be demolished) and Figure 3, which were sent to you in February 1992.

I therefore confirm that the buildings to be demolished in the Leeke Street Block are 8-16 (even) Leeke Street and 1-5 (odd) Field Street.

CAVII: Britannia Street Block

With regard to the duplicate conservation area application for Britannia Street Block, I confirm that number 163 King's Cross Road is not included in the application parcel.

The application was revised on 18 September 1992 to exclude the Golden Lion Public House at number 2 Britannia Street. Copies of the revised Figures 1 to 6 inclusive were sent to you at that time I enclose a further set of drawings for your information, as requested. In addition I enclose a copy of Schedule 1 (buildings to be demolished).

I confirm that the buildings to be demolished in the Britannia Street Block are 4-26 (even) Britannia Street; 165-1/1 King's Cross Road; 1-3 (odd) Leeke Street and 5-13 (odd) Leeke Street.

Please let me know if you require any further information prior to the Committee receing on 15 October 1992.
