Dear Sirs,

Re 1 - 5 Field Street, Kings Cross.

We have been recommend by the Engineers & Surveyors Dept. of the Met. Borough of St. Pancras, to write you with regard to the above site.

Since it appears that probably years may elapse before permanent buildings can be replaced on the above sites, and also on that of 6 and 6a, Field Street, we desire to know whether your Council would permit the erection of temporary buildings, such as would be suitable for carrying on light industrial work, (for which the site is zoned) on these sites, which are urgently necessary to enable us to resume our pre-war occupations, which cannot be embarked on until more space is available.

We are working under extremely difficult conditions, endeavouring in some degree to fill the requirements of our pre-war Clientele, to the extent of about 25% of our pre-war capacity.

If such permission can be granted, you might indicate the approximate time for which such licence would be granted, so that we in turn can decide the type of building and materials we could adopt which would both suit our purpose, and be economically possible.
