Hi John,

We understand a question has been raised regarding the proposal to use a conveyor to remove material from the construction site out to Arkwright Road for collection. We confirm that it is possible to install a conveyor system that would not involve removal of any existing trees other than those indicated on the proposals.

We attach our drawing and marked up photo showing the suggested route that follows the side passage between the houses and cuts across the grass to link with the existing path leading to the end of the garden. This was sent to a conveyor specialist (https://www.coveya.co.uk) who produced their own diagram to confirm that the arrangement is feasible.

I hope that this provides sufficient reassurance, please let me know if anything else is required.


