This could mean that the felled tree is not removed from the garden, that the stump and roots remain in situ, or that no replacement landscaping (e.g. provision of a new tree and new grass) is provided for. Greenery is an essential part of the Swiss Cottage conservation area, and removing the tree without providing for a suitable replacement tree and landscaping will reduce the amenity for the leaseholders and occupants of [REDACTED] surrounding properties overlooking the garden.</p> <p>Whilst there is no objection to reducing the tree's overbearing impact on the garden, it is hoped that the council will aim to preserve the amenity in the built environment and the character and appearance of the conservation area.</p>
