Dear Mr Coltrini,

I wish to make objection to your recently revised CMP for 100 Avenue Road.

Already the noise levels in our neighbourhood make it difficult to enjoy sitting in our gardens in good weather but worse still is the fact that Finchley Road is vastly over the levels allowed by the EU directive on NO2 emissions and that of Particulate matter.

I was diagnosed with asthma, caused by aerial pollution about 1 year ago. I now have to use two different spray if I venture out to the shops or the station in my neighbourhood.

The NO2 levels are already 63% higher than allowed and now you propose to use more lorries than originally stated in your management plan.  
The noise and vibration to buildings and the danger to children living in the area is simply NOT ACCEPTABLE

Add to that the increase in idling of traffic as journeys are slowed by all and increased construction traffic in this already congested area.

This scheme should never have been granted permission. It will be an eyesore to our skyline, completely out of scale with its surroundings.
