We have strong objections to the new CMP proposals for the following reasons:

- The very considerable increase in pollution levels particularly Nitrogen Dioxide (NO₂) that will result from the 415% increase from the originally planned to the proposed 25 construction lorries, including 11 massive 54ft articulated lorries per day!! The Nitrogen Dioxide levels in the Swiss Cottage Open Space area are already 63% over the acceptable EU limit.
- Our Open Space area is the only green lung in the area where children play and families come for some respite from the noise and pollution of Finchley Road ! Acceptance of the CMP would mean a travesty of our right to clean air for the next three years!
- We are particularly concerned about the effect of the increased NO₂ levels on children. It is a known fact that exposure to high levels of NO₂ irritates the lungs airways and contributes to the development of asthma and increases the risk of lung cancer.

We would recommend that Essential Living monitor the quality of air and NO₂ levels by installing a pollution monitor so that we are all aware of what we are breathing when we are in the area.
