The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reason:

1 The proposed dormer, by reason of its siting, size and design, would be an overly dominant and incongruous addition which would disrupt the uniformity of the well-preserved local roofscape. As such the proposals would cause harm to the character and appearance of the host property, the streetscape and the surrounding conservation area contrary to policies D1 (Design) and D2 (Heritage) of the Local Plan (2017) and policies DC3 and DC4 of the Referendum version of the Dartmouth Park Neighbourhood Plan.
