I write to strongly object to the outrageous proposals of Essential Living Developers wish to contravene their agreed traffic plan of no more than 7, 34ft lorries a day for 3 years in the construction of an unwanted-by the public- towerblock at 100 Avenueroad in Swiss Cottage. Essential Living now want to increase the daily number of HGVs from the agreed 7 to 25 including 11 massive 54ft articulated lorries for 3 years. The Nitrogen Dioxide levels here are already 63 percent above the EU limit (Imperial College). It is well documented that (NO2) exposure is associated with respiratory symptoms, reduced lung function which in those with chronic bronchitis and asthma can and often is fatal, asthma and reduced birth weight etc. Air pollution is the world's largest environmental risk, killing about 7 million people every year (Clean Air London). All traffic must be restricted to existing major roads ie the A41. The Swiss Cottage Green Space is designed only for pedestrians and is a unique and badly needed play area for children and recreational space for the many nearby residents including those in the Mora Burnet House care home who have no garden of their own. It is an important thoroughfare for all local residents, users of Swiss Cottage Library, Sports Centre, and Community Centre. This Green Space must remain protected for the health and safety of all of its users young and old alike. The increase in pollution of the already polluted atmosphere and the increase in noise and vibration levels that would be the inevitable result of the proposal of The Developers must not be permitted. The Developers therefore must be held to comply with their original agreed plan of no more than 7, 34ft lorries per day on site via the A41 road only - however much they wish otherwise.
