OBJECTION to the revised CMP

As a Swiss Cottage resident of many years, a long-time user of the Library, the Leisure Centre, Gym, the Community Centre, a patron of the Theatre, a lover of the Cherry Blossom and the rose bushes surrounding the Open Space where students picnicking on the grass and children playing in the water feature bring a smile to one's face, I am saddened and infuriated by the duplicitous dealings of EL and Camden.

It would appear that, from the outset, the huge, and increased, number of heavy lorries was always intended to use the Open Space, to our detriment. The vibrations, noise and air pollution beside the children's sports and play area are unacceptable. It must be possible to increase the space allocated to lorries on the A41, further away from the path, the buildings, people's houses and the old folks' home. Surely Transport for London can close the Avenue Road access to the underground station, which would then channel more people away from the dust and noise pollution either by the exit by the Swiss Cottage pub or across the road at Belsize Road.
