Informatives:

1 Condition 4c of listed building reference 2019/1132/L requires details of all new replacement doors to be submitted and approved.

The submitted door schedule demonstrates that all of the replacement doors at the property would be 6 panel softwood doors with black metal lever handles and architraves/mouldings to match those of the existing internal doors at the site. The submitted details have been reviewed by the Council's conservation team and are considered to safeguard the special architectural and historic

interest of the building. Condition 4c can therefore be discharged.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. No comments were received prior to making this decision. As such, the details are in general accordance with policies D1 and D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
