The school might prefer the tree be taken down in the Christmas Holidays, so receiving consent very soon would I imagine give the owners the flexibility to organise it's felling with this in mind.</p> <p>If the Tree Officer decides it is inappropriate to put a DD Notice on this tree, then may I urge him to make an urgent decision on the s211 Notice.</p> <p>I am delighted with the choice of tree to replace this TPOed tree: a Tilia Platyphyllos Rubra. This replacement tree will have the TPO transferred to it, so this variety and its columnar form will ensure it is visible from afar, maintaining its public amenity.
