FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Pittisporum (T1) - Reduce crown by 15-20%, thin crown density by 15-20% and raise crown by approximately 0.50 - 1.00m.

1 x Cherry (T2) - Fell to ground level and remove root ball.

1 x Small Cherry (T3) - Fell to ground level and remove root ball.

1 x Olive (T4) - Reduce crown by 20%, thin crown density by 20% and remove low secondary stem growing towards the house.

1 x Elder(T5) - Fell to ground level and remove root ball.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 22 October 2019 and does not wish to object.
