The Council has considered your application and decided to grant approval of details.

Condition 7 required the submission of a tree schedule to include details of replacement tree planting including replanting specials, position, date, size and details of when trees shall be replanted. The applicant has provided such a schedule which has been reviewed by the Council's tree officer and considered to be sufficient to ensure the development would achieve a high quality of landscaping to contribute to the visual amenity and character of the area.

Condition 15 required the submission of all hard and soft landscaping across the development site. The applicant has provided detailed plans of all of the areas of landscaping together with a management and maintenance plan. The details are considered sufficient for the requirements of condition 15 and would ensure a high quality of landscaping. The details have been reviewed by the Green Space officer and considered appropriate. Therefore the requirements of condition 15 have been met.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the host building and surrounding conservation area.

As such, the proposed details are in general accordance with policy CS14, CS15 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

2 Conditions 40 and 44 of planning permission 2015/3076/P dated 09/12/2015 remain outstanding and are currently under consideration by the Council.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraph 38 of the National Planning Policy Framework 2019.
