The brick pillars, metal gates and railings, by reason of their design, height and siting, create an unduly visually prominent and discordant feature, which harms the character and appearance of the host building, streetscene and the Redington and Frognal Conservation Area, contrary to policies D1 and D2 of the Camden Local Plan 2017.
