Request for Observations to Adjoining Borough - No objection

Address:

47 Avenue Road London NW8 6BS

Proposal: Installation of pedestrian gates within the existing wall along Avenue Road, raise the boundary wall along Acacia Road and Townshend Road, installation of railings to the top of the boundary walls to Avenue Road, Acacia Road and Townshend Road and new gates to Townshend Road with hedges behind.

The Council, as a neighbouring planning authority, has considered your request for observations on the application referred to above and hereby raises no objection.

Informative:

The boundary treatments of properties along this stretch of the west side of Avenue Road use a combination of low walls with or without railings to reach a consistent height. It is considered that the proposed alterations to the boundary treatment are at odds with that consistency and result in an overly defensive and uncharacteristic appearance. However the harm caused is not considered so substantial that it would harm the character and appearance of the Elsworthy Conservation Area on the east side of Avenue Road. The Council, therefore raises no objection and the application should be determined under City of Westminster's planning policies.
