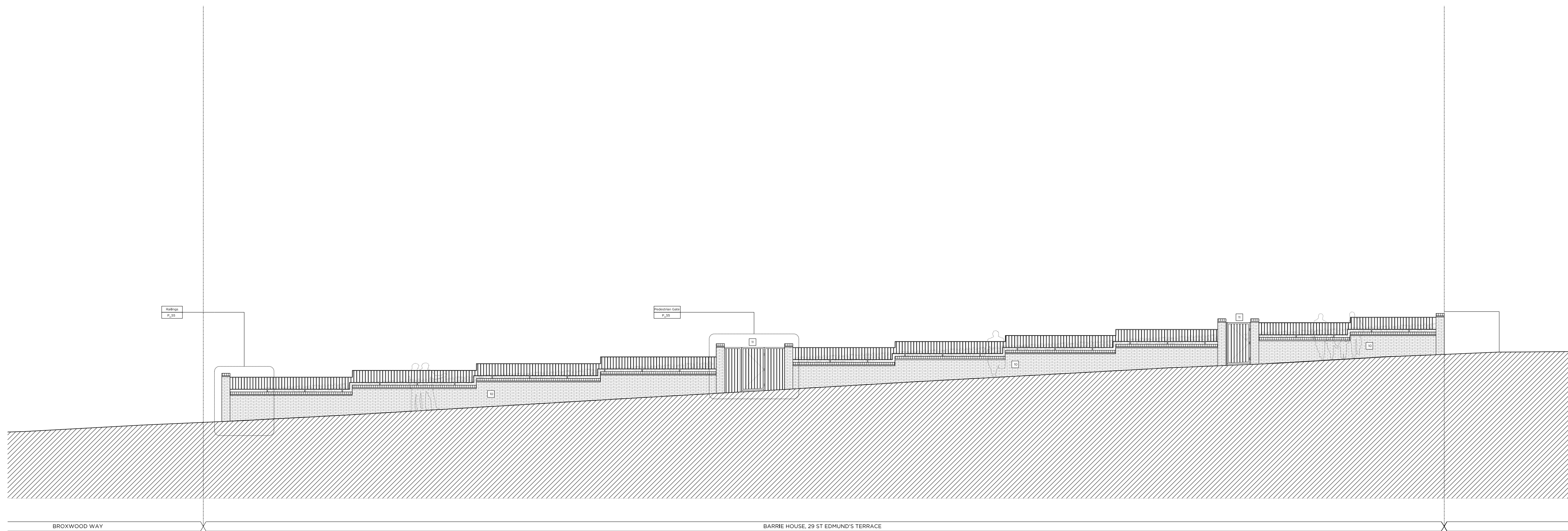


PROPOSED SOUTHWEST BOUNDARY TREATMENT
