### **NO OBJECTION TO SECTION 211 NOTICE OF WORKS TO TREE/S IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

Proposed Work:

FRONT GARDEN: 1 x Leyland Cypress (*Cupressocyparis leylandii*) (T2) - Reduce crown height by 1.5 metres and trim the sides by up to 0.5m to form a tight and tidy crown.

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Laurel (*Prunus* spp) (T4) - Reduce all aspects of the crown by 1m and reduce overhanging sections to the rear over the neighbouring property by up to 1m.

1 x Unknown (T5) - Reduce all aspects of the crown by 1m.

1 x Ash (*Fraxinus excelsior*) (T6) - Reduce all aspects of the crown by 1 - 1.5m.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 19 November 2019 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS



3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.

- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests from construction works.
