Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The lime trees are highly visible from the public realm and are considered to make a positive contribution to the character of the conservation area. The trees have been managed by regular reduction at a similar height to trees in adjacent gardens. It is considered that the proposed works would be detrimental to the visual amenity the trees provide within the street scene and the character of the conservation area.
